Note: We have limited space on these programs, as they fill up rapidly.



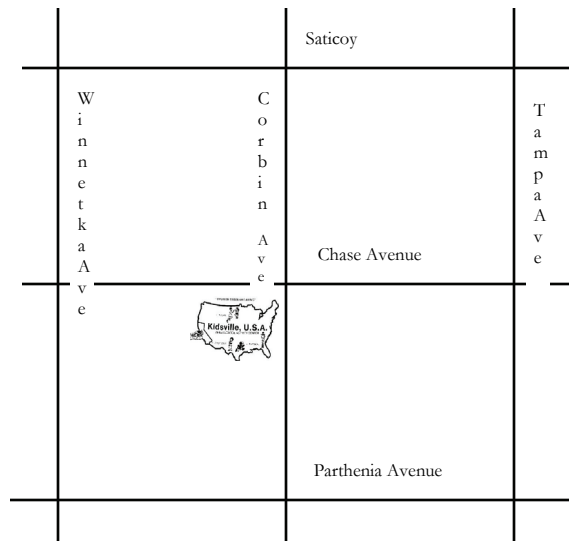
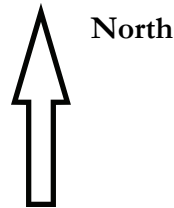
Extra Curricular activities

Our Philosophy

Our Curriculum

Infant And Toddler Program

The Infant and Toddler environments are structured to provide a variety of motor as well as sensory experiences. The children are encouraged to physically master the environment as they move through the rooms and the outdoors. Specific activities involving crawling, walking, balancing, jumping and running also are planned to facilitate motor development. All areas of the room provide fine motor activities such as turning book pages, finger painting and putting together simple puzzles. Sensory- motor experiences are integrally bound to the children's cognitive and language development.



18 months - 2 years old:

The sole purpose of the 2 year old curriculum is to enhance the development skill of your growing child. In realizing this, we encourage and work with children on gross motor skills, oral language development, physical development, socialization and music and toilet tanning.



3 year Old:

The most important aspect of a child's growth is the foundation. We are Kidsville, U.S.A. Children's Center strive to build a solid foundation in our toddler curriculum. With our emphasis to educational excellence, we ensure that each child will grow academically. With our social activities we ensure that the children have the opportunity to grow socially and emotionally. We teach the importance of sharing and the basic understanding of individuality of each other.



Pre-School and Kindergarten....

In keeping with our motto "education with no limits", we intend to provide each child with the opportunity of a structured environment that encourages learning and social interaction. In our pre-school and Kindergarten curriculum, we teach children math skills, reading, language skills, logical analysis, motor skills and sequential thinking along with activities that improve eye hand coordination. We conduct regular assessments and work on areas of improvement of the pre-school child for their success and growth.

At Kidsville USA, we take advantage of the fact that all children want to learn about their world and to experience success. Instead of turning the process of learning into a chore, Kidsville, U.S.A. capitalizes on the intellectual curiosity and the creative spirit inherent in every child. Teachers actively involve students. Students encounter a project-oriented curriculum that enables them to apply facts and concepts so that knowledge is lively and has purpose. Classes are discussion-based rather than teacher-dominated. An average class size of twelve to fifteen students enables teachers to know and understand how each child learns best and to vary techniques to meet the strengths of each child.
